Regional Chapter Guidelines

General Guidelines

- 1. Organize a local leadership team. The structure is flexible.
- 2. Review the Mission of AATH and establish goals and a timeline for your group.
- 3. Plan your first meeting and come to consensus about forming a local chapter.
- 4. Fill out the AATH application form for a Local Chapter Charter and submit to the AATH management office.
- 5. Fees and dues (AATH is a non-profit organization):
 - a. Dues shall be minimal to cover costs of operations-if dues are charged an annual financial report will be sent to management office.
 - b. No or nominal cost for members (Admission fee to cover expenses)
 - c. Non-members attend the first meeting admission free. Subsequent fee decisions are up to the local leadership team. AATH Membership brochures should be available for those interested.
- 6. Decide on dates, time and places for meetings.
- 7. Market this event to AATH members in your region. Notify the management office so your event can be advertised in the Humor Connection.
- 8. Fundraisers to support the international mission of AATH are welcome. Please keep the AATH board informed of your fundraisers so we can support your efforts.
